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## THE MEANTIME COFFEE CO. PRIORITIZES SUSTAINABILITY IN BUSINESS OPERATIONS

## Why does Meantime value sustainability?

- Meantime is committed to offering products that are ethically sourced to serve as a <u>sustainable food hub</u> on campus and promote responsible consumption.
- Meantime frequently partners with small businesses and <u>student organizations</u> to expand its community impact.

## How does Meantime prioritize sustainability efforts?

- Meantime sources its coffee from <u>Carrboro Coffee Roasters</u>, which forms direct relationships with coffee farmers to promote fair global trade.
- Partnerships with local small businesses, including <u>Ninth Street Bakery</u> and <u>UpDog Kombucha</u>, make sustainable products accessible to UNC-Chapel Hill students and faculty.
- Meantime works with <u>CompostNow</u> to reduce waste created by cups, coffee grounds and more.
- Meantime's "Bring Your Own Mug" (BYOM) initiative incentives customers to provide reusable drink containers and reduces waste created by cups, sleeves and lids.
- Offering a variety of free milk alternatives to customers combats environmental impacts of the dairy industry.

## **Quick statistics**

- Meantime's <u>2022 Impact Report</u> begins to survey Meantime's full environmental impact using quantitative analysis and globally recognized <u>Sustainable Development Goals</u>. This report includes data such as:
  - In 2022, Meantime's compost efforts diverted 4,512 tons of waste from the landfill.
  - In 2022, Meantime's BYOM initiative saved 4,500 single-use cups from the landfill.
